XI FIELD PROBLEMS:

From the secretary of the minutes: The current temporary meeting place at “The Dove” in the basement is dark, and has acoustics designed to contain the sound from the rest of the building. It is difficult for all persons in attendance, as well as the secretary of the minutes, to hear the conversation when speakers sit, face away, and speak normally as they would in a face to face conversation. Please be courteous enough to stand, face the audience and speak loudly enough for all to hear.

Discussion of low voltage installations, permit, and inspections: Some jurisdictions require a permit but most do not. Most jurisdictions inspect the low voltage installations while inspecting other electrical installations at the job sites.

Discussion of HB 10-1001 concerning PV array installers: The installers who are state certified receive a frame size certificate but no wallet card that can be verified at the job sites. NEC 705.6 states that these systems must be installed by qualified persons. The consensus for enforcement was unanimous, but the law has no teeth and the PUC is charged with its enforcement. It was suggested that the certified installer needs to show proof of certification to pull the permit. Nameste’ and other certified installers have qualified people to design, draw, and install the systems.
